

Picture Rock

Materials required

- Verse Shape Patterns
- 16-gauge craft wire (variety of colors)
- Wire cutters
- Craft felt (variety of colors

Supplies

- Scissors
- Ruler
- Glue
- Markers
- Pencil

Instructions

- 1. Print out Verse Shape Patterns.
- 2. Cut three 2-feet length of craft wire with wire cutters.
- 3. Lay one wire flat on table. Place a rock in the middle of the wire. Lift up the ends of the wire up and twist them together close to the top of the rock (Figure 1). Repeat with the other two wires, wrapping them in different places around the sides of the rock. Twist the wires so they all meet on top of the rock. Do not trim off excess wire.
- Bend the end of one write (on top of the rock) over the side of a pencil to begin making a spiral (Figure 2). Continue wrapping the write around the pencil and forming a spiral (Figure 3).
- Place the rock on felt and use a marker to trace around the edges (Figure 4).
 Cut out the shape and glue to the bottom of the rock.
- 6. Use markers to decorate the *Verse Shapes*. Carefully slide the shapes into swirls between the rings of wire.

Tip: Paint the rock with acrylic paint before wrapping the wire.







