Rocket Ride Wind Chimes

Materials required

- Rocket Patterns
- Chenille wire
- Clear thread or fishing line
- Sheets of craft form in different colors
- CD disk
- 4 jingle bells

Supplies

- Scissors
- White card stock
- Pen
- Wire cutters
- Colored pencils
- Hole punch
- Measuring stick

Instructions

- 1. Print out Rocket Patterns onto cardstock.
- 2. Tie a 3 foot clear thread around each CD (Figure 1).
- 3. Cut a 6 inch lengh of chenille wire.
- 4. Cut clera thread into 18 inch lengths making four lengths.
- 5. Cut out 4 rocket pattenrs of your choice.
- Trace around the pattern onto a sheet of craft foram and cut out the foam shape.
 Repeat this for all four rockets.
- 7. Punch holes in the foam rockets at the large dots.
- 8. Use a pen to add faces to the people in the rockets. Add words or designs to the sides of the rockets.
- 9. Bend the chnille wires into four hanges (s-shaped, spring or swirl shaped).
- 10. Ben on end of a hanger around the thread that is wrapped around the CD (Figure
 - 2). Repeat this stpe for the other three rockets.
- 11. Tie a jingle bell to the end of a short length of clera thread. Repeat this step for all rockets.
- 12. Thread a rocket onto Each length of thread tied with a jingle bell. Now tie the other end of the threat to a chnille write hanger on the CD (Figure 3).. Do this for all rockets and bells.
- 13. Hook hangers onto the threads of the CD at equal intervals.



