Bible Story Game

Hula Hoopla

Equipment

- Butcher paper
- 3 hula hoops
- Masking tape
- Markers
- Frisbees



Preparation

- 1. Attach butcher paper to wall.
- Tape hula hoops together to form a triangle. Attach to 2 chairs so the hula hoop
 triangle is held upright. Place chairs and hula hoops about 2 feet in front of the butcher
 paper.
- 3. On the butcher paper, in the space behind each hula hoop, print the following:
 - o Behind one of the bottom hops print "500".
 - o Behind the top hoops, print "1000".
 - Behind the top hoop, print "2000."
- 4. Use marking tape to make a starting line about 15 feet away.

<u>Game</u>

- 1. Have children line up behind masking tape.
- 2. Have children take turns throwing the frisbee at the hula hoops.
- 3. When a child gets a Frisbee through a hula hoop, ask them a question from the category.

500 Level Questions - True or False

- The rich young ruler asked Jesus what he had to do to live forever. (True)

1000 Level Questions

- What did Jesus say when the rich young ruler called Him "good"? (Jesus asked why the man had called Him good. He said only God is good.)
- What question did the rich young ruler ask Jesus? (What must I do to have eternal life?)
- What does it mean to have eternal life? (Become a member of God's family and live forever.)
- What did Jesus say the rich young man should do about the commandments? (Obey them.)
- What did the rich young ruler say he did about the commandments? (He'd obeyed them since he was a boy.)
- What did Jesus say the rich young ruler still needed to do? (See all of his stuff and give his money to the poor.)
- What did the rich young ruler do when Jesus told him to sell all of his things? (He walked away. He became sad.)
- What did Jesus say a rich man getting to heave was harder than? (A camel going through the eye of a needle.)
- What did Jesus say is only possible with God? (Being a member of God's family and having eternal life.)

2000 Level Questions

- What did the rich young ruler think he could earn by obeying rules? (Membership in God's family and eternal life.)
- How do you thing the rich young ruler felt about obeying rules? (He liked it. He
 thought he was rich because he was good at obeying rules.)
- How do you think the rich young ruler felt about having obeyed the commandments since he was young? (He was proud and that God was pleased with him.)
- Why was the rich young ruler sad when he walked away? Why wasn't he angry? (He probably did love God. Je just loved money more.)
- What mistake did the disciples believe about being rich? (That people became rich because God was pleased with them and they were members of His family.)
- What conclusions can you draw from Jesus' statement that God is the only One
 who can give eternal life? (No one can be rich enough or good enough or obey enough
 rules to earn their way into God's family.)
