Blind Man Mask

Materials required

- Mask pattern
- Tan colored card stock
- Light weight muslin (or similar fabric)
- Paint stir stick or large popsicle stick
- Metal paper fastener

Supplies

- Scissors
- Glue
- Pen
- Markers or crayons

Preparation

- 1. Print mark patterns onto card stock.
- 2. Cut fabric into 2x24 inch strip.
- 3. Cut out Mask Pattern 1. Cut around eyes and mouth as well.
- 4. Cut out Mask Pattern 2
- 5. Using the tip of a pen, poke a hole in the dot in the center of the masks.
- 6. Color the eyes, mouth and hair on each mask.
- 7. Position the circle face behind the man's face with the facial features. Insert a metal paper fastener through the hole in both masks and spread the ends of the fastener to secure the masks together (Figure 1).
- 8. Glue on a strip of fabric to make a head covering. You can also glue strips of yarn, for hair, to the masks (Figure 2).
- 9. Use a marker to write "1 John 3:14-144 on the stick. Glue the stick to the back side of the mask's neck so the verse is facing the front (Figure 3)
- 10. When the circle face behind the mask is rotated, the blind man can go from closed eye to open eyes.




