

Tuesday - Memory Verse Game

Skee Spree Game

Equipment

- Scissors
- Small, medium & large cardboard box
- Duct tape
- 2x4 foot piece of cardboard or thin plywood
- Tennis balls
- Garbage can or other object



Preparation

1. Print verse (page 2) and verse cards (page 3).
2. Cut out verse cards.
3. If necessary, cut sides of boxes down so each is no more than 2 feet tall.
4. For each team, place small cardboard box in center of medium box, and medium box in center of large box.
5. Use duct tape in bottom of boxes to secure them.
6. In front of box, prop piece of cardboard or plywood on a diagonal slant using an overturned can or other object to create a ramp.
7. Place cards next to ramp.

Game

1. Using the poster, read the verse aloud.
2. Have children line up in front of the ramp. Have each child take a turn rolling one ball up and off the ramp, trying to land in the smallest box.
3. If a ball lands outside any box, no verse cards are given to the child. If the ball lands in the biggest box, the child gathers one verse card. If the ball lands in the medium box, the child gathers 2 verse cards. If the ball lands in the smallest box, the child gathers 3 verse cards.
4. Once all the cards have been handed out, the children put the cards in order and read the verse aloud.
