

King's Crown

Materials required

- *Crown Pattern*
- Sheets of yellow craft foam
- Glitter glue
- Self-adhesive craft foam shapes
- Stickers
- Small plastic gems or sequins
- 3 large plastic gems
- 3 plastic coins (silver or gold)
- Plastic headband
- Gold card stock

Supplies

- Scissors
- Glue
- Markers
- Crayons
- Pen
- Hot Glue gun

Instructions

1. Print out *Crown Pattern*. Trace it on yellow craft foam and cut out.
2. Glue a large plastic gem on each hump of the crown's front piece.
3. Glue three plastic coins in the center or along the lower portion of the crown (Figure 1).
4. Decorate the front piece using craft foam shapes, stickers, markers, small plastic gems, crayons and glitter glue (Figure 2).
5. Have an adult hot glue the front portion of the crown around the edge of a plastic headband (Figure 3).
6. Carefully slide the headband so it fits across your forehead and the crown portion points upward.

Tip

- To simplify, omit gems and coins and decorate with markers and crayons

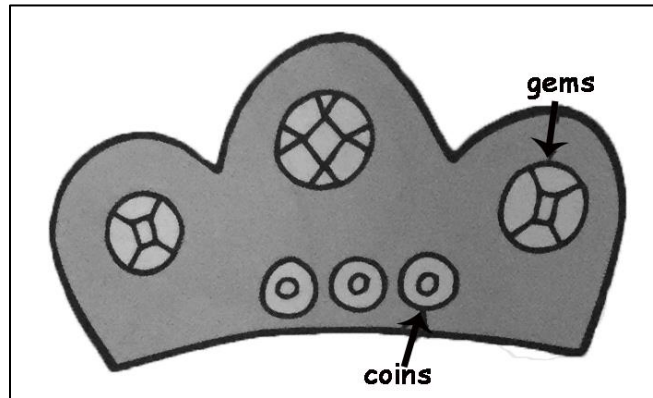

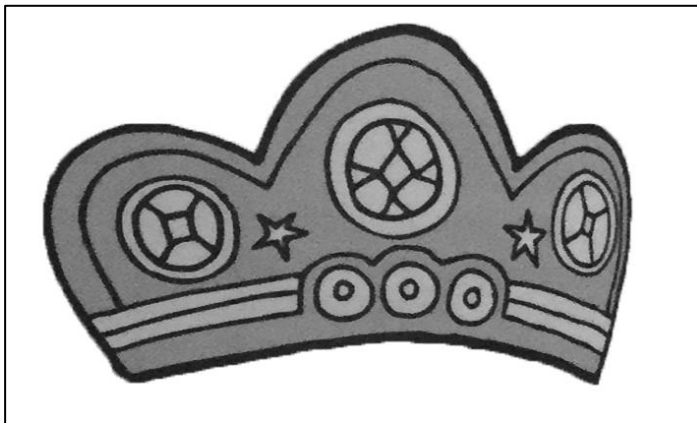

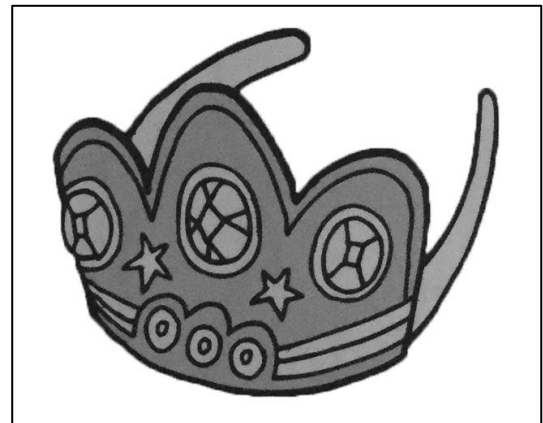
